## Summation of group responses to the questions guiding the discernment process

The following are the similarities and common themes found throughout the responses to each question.

#### I. Listening:

- > Busyness of priests keeps them from being able to interact with and listen to parishioners
- ➤ Identifying and welcoming visitors greeting them and engaging them before and after Mass must be emphasized
- Questions about the proper formation of youth means that education opportunities for the youth should be offered
- There should be a focus on outreach and inclusiveness. Certain groups tend to be exclusive.
- ➤ A greater promotion of events would be helpful
- Greater recognition and involvement of women is asked for
- There is an overall interest in increasing nuns' presence and participation in the church. Consecrated men and women should be utilized more, and there should be greater support for them.
- > We need to learn to hear God's voice through other people. We often don't realize how God might be trying to speak to us.
- > We are often selective as to who we listen to and interact with
- Greater importance should be placed on youth ministers. The church should invest more in youth ministry.
- > There is disaffiliation from the church because of a lack of understanding, especially of the Mass
- The need for instant gratification is a hindrance to listening, understanding, and being patient towards others
- There is a need to listen to those with different opinions. There is a fear of being judged and ostracized, particularly in youth.
- Parishes should give new people the opportunity to participate and lead rather than letting the same group of people be in control for many years

# II. Sharing Responsibility for Our Common Mission:

- ➤ Importance of answering questions that youth pose
- There are questions/concerns about where the money in churches is going: Is the church prioritizing building/structural needs over the needs of the people we serve and evangelize?
- > There should be more opportunities for learning and formation. Apologetics is needed to be able to evangelize.

- ➤ Parishes should offer creative and attractive educational opportunities for youth
- There should be better and more opportunities to communicate between parishioners and priest/parish staff. Parishes should look for creative ways to let parishioners ask questions, express needs, and make suggestions.
- > Broken families should be attended to
- There is a need to remember and prioritize the mission of the church
- Outreach in the community must be emphasized
- > People would like more clarity on what the laity is called to do in the community
- Parishioners should feel a greater sense of ownership
- ➤ We must share the Gospel with everyone, not just Catholics
- There are different opinions regarding the Latin Mass: some argue that it should be more available, others argue that some parishes focus on it too much.
- There should be more guidance on instructing and supporting parents

## III. Forming Ourselves in Synodality:

- There should be a greater engagement of those in the periphery
- ➤ Homilies should be more reflective and practical to the audience
- There is an overall concern that other churches are being more attractive to youth and causing them to leave
- ➤ Walking together as a synodal church is more than just fellowship
- > Receptivity to change, participating in mission is key
- There is a need to form ourselves in prayer
- > Importance of adhering to the truths of the faith and not watering down the doctrine
- > Sometimes we need to give children/youth a good foundation but give them the space to explore and find their way back
- > There needs to be greater clarification on where resources for ministries and outreach are available
- Adopting a one-on-one communication approach would be more effective
- There should be a greater focus on the Eucharist
- > Emphasis should be made on listening to people outside the church, overcoming prejudices and stereotypes
- > People should be more open to change
